### 1 Introduction

The GREEN TALES project aims to enhance green awareness education for children through arts and digital tools. During the 2024/2025 school year, 153 children were involved with artists and teachers in creative workshops in four schools in Germany, Iceland, Spain, and Turkey. Together they created eight short stories together with drawings, sounds, music... on the 4 elements (earth, air, water, fire) and a final animated movie, using storytelling and digital techniques like stop-motion animation, fostering creativity and green awareness.
